There will also be free time to enjoy Palazzola (18 miles from Rome above Lake Albano) as well as trips to: Castel Gandolfo **where we will join the Pope for the Angelus**, Subiaco monastery where St Benedict started his religious life, and an evening visit to the Villa D'Este to see its floodlit fountains.
