1st Reading: Zechariah 9:9-10; 2nd Reading: Romans 8:9, 11-13 Gospel: Matthew 11:25-30

Theme: God reveals Himself to the poor

The gospel shows Jesus "gentle & humble," that is, on the side of the poor & the oppressed. He rejoices because it is to them that the Father has revealed his message of salvation. In the first reading we find the words of the prophet announcing a Messiah who is poor & humble. These appear to be words that describe Jesus. The second reading can be linked to this theme because it speaks of the Spirit who can only be received by the poor, by those who are "humble in heart."

Response to the Psalm: I will bless your name for ever, my God and King.

In 2013 Jerome Hunt, a local professional painter, produced a picture of the west front of Peterborough Cathedral. It is a striking piece of work, painted at a time when the sun is closer to the horizon and the shadows of the three Gothic arches give the picture a tremendous sense of 3 dimensionality. It could be compared with paintings of the west front of Rouen Cathedral by Claude Monet during 1892-1893. The size of the painting is 33cm by 35cm and it has been expertly framed, so the painting has the appearance of a much larger work. It would look magnificent on the wall of a family home. We are selling tickets to give someone a chance to win this one-off piece of local history. All proceeds for the sale of tickets will go to All Souls Building Fund – for the necessary works to our church.
